AN ACT Relating to Exhaust Pipes on Certain Motor Vehicles.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 22, § 44-A, additional. Chapter 22 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 44-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 44-A. Exhaust pipes on certain vehicles. All motor vehicles using diesel engine fuel shall be equipped with vertical exhaust pipes, so that the end of such exhaust pipes shall be at least 5 feet from the ground.'
