## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Sales of Goods and Merchandise Other Than at Retail.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 184, § 6-A, additional. Chapter 184 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 6-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 6-A. Sales at other than retail prices. No person, firm or corporation shall sell or assist in the sale of goods, wares and merchandise at other than retail prices unless such sale be made in the usual course of business.'
