## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

AN ACT Permitting Transfer of Town Road Improvement Funds to State Aid Accounts.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 23, § 63, amended. The first sentence of section 63 of chapter 23 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'No money from this fund shall be expended on the improved sections of any road which is a part of the federal aid, State, State aid, 3rd class or so-called CCC roads, as it is intended to apply only to the unimproved roads of the State; provided, however, that the above limitation shall not apply to the \$200 referred to in section 6r provided, however, that the whole or any portion of the apportionment to any town made under the provisions of sections 60 and 61, may be transferred to the state aid account upon request by the municipal officers and approval by the Commission, and all town road improvement funds so transferred shall be expended in accordance with the provisions of the State aid laws.'
