AN ACT Relating to Penalty for Transporting Live Fish in Certain Counties.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 37, § 63-A, additional. Chapter 37 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 63-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 63-A. Transportation of live bait in certain counties. It shall be unlawful to transport live bait in the counties of Aroostook, Franklin, Piscataquis, Oxford and Somerset. Whoever violates any provision of this section shall be punished by a fine of \$100.'
