IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Bounty on Bobcats.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 37, § 121, amended. The 1st sentence of section 121 of chapter 37 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'There shall be a bounty of \$15 for every bobeat loupcervier and Canada lynx and \$30 for every bobcat which is killed within the State, to be paid by the Treasurer of State to the person killing the same upon compliance with the following conditions.'
