**AN ACT Relating to Validity of Acts of Selectmen.**

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 91, § 82-A, additional.** Chapter 91 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 82-A, to read as follows:

**'Sec. 82-A. Majority of selectmen to act. No action of the selectmen of a town shall be valid unless approved or ratified by a majority of the selectmen.'**
