AN ACT Relating to Liquor License Credit.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 61, § 52, amended. The last sentence of section 52 of chapter 61 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'This section shall not prohibit a wholesaler from receiving normal credits for the purchase of malt liquor from the manufacturer thereof within or without the State; **nor shall this section prohibit any hotel, restaurant, tavern, club or retail store from receiving normal credit for the purchase of malt liquor from a wholesaler within the State.**'
