STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

AN ACT Permitting Importation of Lobster Meat for Commercial Freezing and Canning.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 38, § 116, amended. The first sentence of the fifth paragraph of section 116 of chapter 38 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'It shall be lawful for holders of a wholesale seafood dealer's and processor's license to receive meat from other states and countries providing such meat is immediately processed and either hermetically sealed in all metal or metal and glass containers or commercially wrapped and frozen for resale as processed stews, newburgs, or chowders or lobster products in the retail or institutional trade.'
