STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

AN ACT Providing for Medical Aid to Indians.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 25, § 334-A, additional. Chapter 25 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 334-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 334-A. Medical aid. Every member of either Indian tribe shall be entitled to receive needed medical aid, to be paid for by the State.'
