# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

#### AN ACT Relating to Number of Employees under Group Life Insurance Policies.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 60, § 164, sub-§ 1, ¶ A, amended. The second sentence of paragraph A of subsection I of section 164 of chapter 60 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

The policy may provide that the term "employees" shall include the employees of I or more subsidiary corporations, the employees of I or more corporations with which the employer, having not less than 25 10 employees of its own, is under contract to provide specified services at cost and the employees, individual proprietors and partners of I or more affiliated orporations, proprietors or partnerships if the business of the employer and of such affiliated corporations, proprietors or partnerships is under common control through stock ownership or contract.'

- Sec. 2. R. S., c. 60, § 164, sub-§ I, ¶ C, amended. Paragraph C of subsection I of section 164 of chapter 60 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:
  - 'C. The policy must cover at least 25 10 employees at date of issue.'
