IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to School Subsidy Allocations.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 41, § 237, amended. Section 237 of chapter 41 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new paragraph, which shall be inserted after the third paragraph to read as follows:

'Whenever, because of a change in classification, the basic annual subsidy allocation of a city, town or plantation, as determined by the provisions of this section, is increased or decreased from the basic annual subsity allocation for the preceding biennium, such increase or decrease shall be limited to 25% of the difference between the allocations above referred to in the first year of the biennium and to 50% of the difference in the second year of the biennium.'
