STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

RESOLVE, Appropriating Money for the Preparation of Educational Materials on Maine for Schools.

School materials on Maine to be prepared. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$2,500 from the general fund of the State to be expended by the Department of Education for the preparation and distribution of teaching materials and information for use in courses on Maine in the schools of the State; such materials to be concerned with the history, geography, government and people of Maine and the resources and opportunities of the State.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

It is essential that the schools of the State give courses to the pupils relating to the State of Maine so that our future citizens will be well-informed in all phases of Maine's history, both past and present. If we are to sell Maine to the rest of the nation our future leaders should be equipped with the necessary information.
