STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
FIFTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to the Study of Maine History and Government in Secondary Schools.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 41, § 11, sub-§ VII, amended. Subsection VII of section 11 of chapter 41 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new paragraph which shall read as follows:

'It is further provided that a course on the history, geography and government of Maine, which shall include study of the organization and functions of the State and local governments, the rights and duties of citizens, the natural and industrial resources and opportunities of the State, shall be taught in all schools of secondary grade, both public and private, and that such course must be taken by all secondary school pupils, both public and private, as a requirement for graduation from such secondary schools.'
