STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Penalty for Selling Deer.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 37, § 101, amended. Section 101 of chapter 37 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof a new paragraph to read as follows:

'Whoever violates any provision of this section shall, in addition to any other penalty provided by the provisions of this chapter, be punished by imprisonment for not less than 30 days, and such sentence of imprisonment shall not be suspended.'
