IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED

AN ACT Relating to Penalty for Night Hunting for Deer.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 37, § 77, amended. The third paragraph of section 77 of chapter 37 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'No person shall have in his possession at any time any wild animal, or part thereof, taken in violation of the provisions of this section except as provided in section 113. Any person convicted of a violation under the provisions of this section shall be punished for the 1st offense by a fine of not less than \$200 ~~and costs~~, nor more than \$400 ~~and costs~~, ~~which fine and costs shall not be suspended, and an additional penalty of not more than 30 days in jail, at the discretion of the court together with costs of court, and by imprisonment for not less 10 days, nor more than 30 days, and such sentence of fine, costs and imprisonment shall not be suspended;~~ and for a 2nd or subsequent offense, by a fine of not less than \$400 and costs, nor more than \$800 and costs, and 30 days in jail, which fine, costs and jail sentence shall not be suspended, and an additional penalty of not more than 60 days in jail, at the discretion of the court.'
