STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Retirement of Officers of the Legislature.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 10, § **7-A, additional.** Chapter 10 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 7-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 7-A. Non-legislative year salaries. Any officer of the Legislature whose salary is fixed by sections 4 and 7 who shall become eligible for retirement under the provisions of the Maine State Retirement System shall receive, during the year that the Legislature is not in regular session, a salary not less than the equivalent to the amount he would receive had he retired on January ist of that year.'
