AN ACT Relating to Publication of Specimen Ballots.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 5, § 2, amended. The second sentence of section 2 of chapter 5 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'The Secretary of State shall likewise cause to be published prior to the day of any such election, in at least 2 newspapers **whether daily, weekly or monthly**, if there be so many printed or published in each county, representing so far as practicable, the political parties which, at the preceding election, cast the largest and next largest numbers of votes, a specimen ballot of all such nominations, so far as may be, in the form in which they shall appear upon the general ballots.'
