COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 468, L.D. 1311, Bill, "An Act Relating to the Keeping of Records by Persons in the Business of Selling Dogs."

Amend said Bill by striking out that part designated "Sec. 27" and inserting in place thereof the following:

" ' Sec. 27. Persons buying or selling dogs to keep record. All persons or kennels engaged in buying or selling dogs must keep record of from whom bought and to whom sold, which record shall be open to inspection by local police officers er, humane agents, or the Commissioner of Agriculture or his agent."
