STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to the Keeping of Records by Persons in the Business of Selling Dogs.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 100, § 27, amended. Section 27 of chapter 100 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 27. Persons buying or selling dogs to keep record. All persons or kennels engaged in buying or selling dogs must keep record of from whom bought and to whom sold, which record shall be open to inspection by local police officers or humane agents the Commissioner of Agriculture or his agent.'
