# STATE OF MAINE

#### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

#### AN ACT Relating to "Antique Auto" Plates.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 22, § 1, amended. Section 1 of chapter 22 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding in alphabetical order thereof, the following definition:

"Antique motor car" shall mean any motor vehicle over 25 years old which is maintained solely for use in exhibitions, club activities, parades and other functions of public interest and which is not used primarily for the transportation of passengers or goods over any way."

Sec. 2. R. S., c. 22, § 13, amended. Section 13 of chapter 22 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding after the 3rd paragraph thereof, the following paragraphs:

'The registration of an antique motor vehicle as described in this chapter shall be upon a form prescribed by the Secretary of State. Said registration shall be accompanied by an affidavit provided by the Secretary of State, which affidavit shall include a statement of the age and intended use of said motor vehicle, and that said applicant is a resident of the State of Maine.

The fee for the registration of an antique motor vehicle shall be \$2.50 and in addition to the number plates furnished, the Secretary of State shall issue an identifying clip tab, which tab shall be nontransferrable.'

Sec. 3. R. S., c. 22, § 16, sub-§ V-A, additional. Section 16 of chapter 22 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto after subsection V, a new subsection V-A, to read as follows:

'V-A. Antique motor vehicles ...... \$2.50 each.'
