## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

AN ACT Amending the Maine Employment Security Law as to Seasonal Employment.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- R. S., c. 29, § 21, sub-§ I, amended. Subsection I of section 21 of chapter 29 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:
  - **I.** As used in this section the terms "seasonal industry" and "seasonal occupation" means mean an ocupation or industry in which, because of the seasonal nature thereof it is customary to operate only during a regularly recurring period or periods of less than 40 weeks in a calendar year. The Commission shall must after investigation and hearing investigate, hold hearings, determine, and may shall thereafter from time to time redetermine, the longest seasonal period or periods during which, by the best practice of the occupation or industry in question, operations are conducted. Until such determination by the commission, no occupation or industry shall be deemed seasonal.'
