STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Penalty for Failure to Pay Wages Due.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 30, § 50, amended. Section 50 of chapter 30 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto the following paragraph:

'The provisions of this section shall apply to all the officers of any corporation or individual members of a partnership as well as individuals engaged in the business above described and in all cases where there is default of payment to 3 or more employees. The corporation officers, the partnership members or the individuals, who violate the provisions of this paragraph, shall be punished by a fine of not less than \$100 nor more than \$1,000, or by imprisonment for not less than 30 days nor more than 9 months, or by both such fine and imprisonment.'
