STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

AN ACT Providing for a Contingent Account for Androscoggin County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 89, § 15-A, additional. Chapter 89 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding a new section to be numbered 15-A to read as follows:

'Sec. 15-A. Androscoggin county contingent account. There is hereby established a contingent account for Androscoggin county. The county commissioners of Androscoggin county, after public hearing, may allocate from such contingent account amounts not to exceed in total the sum of \$15,000 in any fiscal year. Such allocations may be made to meet any expense necessarily incurred under any requirement of law. Said county commissioners shall determine the necessity for such allocations. At the close of each fiscal year there shall be transferred from county funds an amount sufficient to restore the county contingent account to \$15,000.'
