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**AN ACT Providing for an Additional Assistant Attorney General.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

**Sec. 1. R. S., c. 20, § 6, amended.** Section 6 of chapter 20 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding after the third sentence, a new sentence, to read as follows :

**‘The Attorney General may appoint an Assistant Attorney General to assist in matters relating to the duties of the office in municipal and county problems.’**

**Sec. 2. Appropriation.** There is hereby appropriated from the general fund the sum of \$6,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1956 and \$6,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1957 to carry out the purposes of this act.
