## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

AN ACT Requiring the Business of Loaning Money to be Conducted on Separate Premises.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 59, § 227-A, additional. Chapter 59 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 227-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 227-A. Separate premises for loaning money. Persons, firms or corporations who are in the business of making any loan of money shall carry on such business in a place where only such business and no other is conducted.'
