STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

AN ACT Defining Malt Beverage Dispensing Parlors.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- R. S., c. 91, § 86, sub-§ II-A, additional. Section 86 of chapter 91 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding a new subsection to be numbered II-A, to read as follows:
 - 'II-A. For establishing police and zoning regulations for malt beer dispensing parlors which are declared to be restaurants, as defined under the provisions of chapter 61, selling malt beverages to an amount in excess of 80% of their total sales; and such malt beer dispensing parlors are hereby declared to be separate and distinct classes of premises for the purpose of this subsection.'
