STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

AN ACT Amending the Charter of the Lewiston Gas Light Company.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1911, c. 16, amended. The 1st sentence of chapter 16 of the private and special laws of 1911, as amended by chapter 18 of the private and special laws of 1921, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'The Lewiston Gas Light Company, a corporation created by special act of the legislature and charged with the performance of a public duty, is hereby authorized to increase its capital stock to not exceeding one million dollars \$2,000,000, and to issue bonds secured by mortgage upon its property and franchise in a sum not exceeding one million dollars \$2,000,000 at any one time outstanding.'
