AN ACT Relating to Political Caucuses.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 4, § 18-A, additional. Chapter 4 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 18-A to read as follows:

'Sec. 18-A. Members of county committees. All members of county committees elected as provided in section 16 shall be nominated at caucuses called and held in the several municipalities of each county.'

Sec. 2. R. S., c. 4, § 12, amended. Section 12 of chapter 4 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 12. Exceptions. The provisions of the 9 preceding sections shall not apply to towns of less than ~~2,000~~ 500 inhabitants, nor to cities wherein the calling and holding of caucuses is regulated by special law.'
