RESOLVE, Authorizing the State Highway Commission to Construct Certain Road in Readfield and Mt. Vernon.

Road in Readfield and Mt. Vernon to be constructed. Resolved: That the State Highway Commission be and hereby is authorized and directed to construct a section of road, situated in the town of Readfield, beginning at the Mt. Vernon town line at the south terminal of State Aid Road No. 3 in Mt. Vernon and extending southerly $\frac{6}{10}$ of a mile to the black top road leading from Readfield Depot to Mt. Vernon Village.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This road is heavily traveled and is used by commuters daily who are employed in the cities of Augusta, Hallowell and the town of Winthrop.
