STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to the Granting of Malt Liquor Licenses.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 61, § 32, amended. Section 32 of chapter 61 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof three new paragraphs, to read as follows:

'No person, firm or corporation shall be granted more than one kind of malt liquor license, and must surrender for cancellation the license he has if he wishes another than the one issued.

No retail store malt liquor licensee shall benefit, either directly or indirectly, except as herein provided in any malt liquor license issued to any hotel, restaurant, tavern or club and no retail malt liquor licensee shall benefit, either directly or indirectly in more than one retail store malt liquor licensee within the State. No restaurant or tavern malt liquor licensee shall benefit, either directly or indirectly, in more than one restaurant or tavern malt liquor license within the State.

No retail store malt liquor licensee shall permit self-service by its customers of malt liquor.'
