SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 503, L.D. 1385, Bill, "An Act  
Relating to the Appointment of Conservators."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the 2nd paragraph thereof and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Sec. 245. Aid may be paid to a guardian or conservator.

When a relative with whom a child is living is found by the Department to be incapable of taking care of his money, payment shall be made only to a legally appointed guardian or conservator ~~of such relative~~ and, notwithstanding the provisions of section 9 of chapter 158 in the matter of infirmities of age or physical disability to manage his estate with prudence and understanding, the probate court may appoint any suitable person as a conservator.'
