STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to the Appointment of Conservators.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 25, § 245, amended. Section 245 of chapter 25 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 245. Aid may be paid to a guardian or conservator. When a relative with whom a child is living is found by the Department to be incapable of taking care of his money, payment shall be made only to a legally appointed guardian or conservator of such relative and, notwithstanding the provisions of section 9 of chapter 158, the probate court may appoint any suitable person as such guardian or conservator.'
