STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Payments of Beneficiary Societies of Children.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 60, § 202, amended. The last sentence of section 202 of chapter 60 of the revised statutes is hereby repealed and the following sentence enacted in place thereof:

'Provided, however, that any such society having admitted assets as shown by its annual statement filed with the Commissioner in excess of 105% of its entire liabilities, including its required reserves, provided that reserves for death benefits are at least equivalent to the amount required by the Commissioners Standard Ordinary Table of Mortality with interest at 3% per annum and computed according to the Commissioner's reserve valuation method, may pay the full amount of the policy at all ages without regard to the aforementioned limitations.
