Bosworth Memorial Association; appropriation for. Resolved: That the sum of \$5,000 be, and hereby is appropriated from the unappropriated surplus of the general fund to be expended by Bosworth Memorial Association to repair the roof and other parts of the building at 44 Free Street, Portland.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

It is the objective of Bosworth Memorial Association to perpetuate the building and property located at 44 Free Street, in Portland, and to maintain same as a memorial to members of Bosworth Post No. 2, Grand Army of the Republic, by whom the property was deeded to the association.
