SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1171, L.D. 1406, Resolve, in Favor
of Helen M. Madsen of Portland.

Amend said Resolve by striking out every thing after the
Title and inserting the following:

'Helen M. Madsen; state pension.'

RESOLVED: That a pension of \$15 per month be, and hereby is,
granted to Helen M. Madsen, of Portland, to be paid monthly from
the appropriation for special legislative pensions. Such pension
shall begin on July 1, 1955 and continue until otherwise provided
by the legislature.'
