RESOLVE, Authorizing the Forest Commissioner to Cut Certain Growth on Route 17.

Cutting of certain growth on Route 17 authorized. Resolved: That the Forest Commissioner be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to trim the growth for scenic purposes from the westerly side of Route 17 in the public lot located in Rangeley Plantation in Franklin County for a distance of not more than ½ a mile to a depth of not more than 175 feet at such locations as he deems advisable; and be it further

Resolved: That the sum of \$1,500 be, and hereby is, appropriated from the unappropriated surplus of the general fund for the above purpose.
