STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE, in Favor of Cyril Swallow of South Paris.

Cyril Swallow; reimbursed. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the general fund of the state the sum of \$10 to be paid to Cyril Swallow of South Paris, as a full and final settlement of his claim against the State for the loss of a jacket taken by an escapee from the Men's Reformatory at South Windham.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

An Army field jacket was taken from the car of Cyril Swallow of South Paris in September of 1953 by one Carroll Murchie from the Reformatory at South Windham. Mr. Murchie told the authorities at Oxford County jail that he had left the jacket in the woods, and Mr. Swallow could not find it, and would like to be reimbursed.
