IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

RESOLVE, in Favor of Raymond Butler of New Gloucester.

Raymond Butler; reimbursed. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the general fund of the state the sum of \$30.23 to be paid to Raymond Butler of New Gloucester, as a full and final settlement of his claim against the State, for damage done to his truck by boys from the Pownal State School.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

In August 1954, 5 boys escaped from the Pownal State School. They ripped grill out of Raymond Butler's 1937 Chevrolet 1½ ton truck, pulled the wires off and broke off the signal lights. Both mirrors were twisted off and never found, and they ran the battery down and took the keys with them. Mr. Whitham of Pownal State School got the keys from the boys.

On September 22, 1954 Mr. Butler paid Harry's Garage, Auburn, Maine, \$30.23 for the above repairs.
