STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

RESOLVE, in Favor of Robert S. Robinson of Westbrook.

Robert S. Robinson; reimbursed. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the general fund of the State the sum of \$219.38 to be paid to Robert S. Robinson of Westbrook, as a full and final settlement of his claim against the State for damage done to personal property and personal property taken by 2 escapees from the Reformatory at South Windham on June 2, 1953.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

On June 2, 1953 two escapees from the Reformatory at South Windham broke into the camp of Robert S. Robinson at Sebago Lake Basin and either took or destroyed personal property in the amount of \$219.38. Of this amount \$20.88 was for food and supplies taken and destroyed; \$198.50 was for clothing, a single shot rifle (22), camera, etc.
