STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

RESOLVE, in Favor of Philip Krisilos of Portland.

Philip Krisilos; reimbursed. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the general fund of the State the sum of \$71.89 to be paid to Philip Krisilos of Portland, as a full and final settlement of his claim against the State for damage done to his restaurant known as the Anchor Lunch at 15 Portland Pier in the City of Portland, by escapees from the State School for Boys in South Portland, on April 29, 1954.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

On April 29, 1954 escapees from the State School for Boys broke into the restaurant of Philip Krisilos at 15 Portland Pier, Portland, and stole and damaged goods in the amount of \$71.89.
