RESOLVE, in Favor of Harriett and George L. Christianson of Portland.

Harriett and George L. Christianson; reimbursed. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the general fund of the State the sum of \$250 to be paid to Harriett and George L. Christianson of Portland, as a full and final settlement of their claim against the State for damage done to personal property and personal property taken by 2 escapees from the State School for Boys on October 2 to 5, inclusive, 1954.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

On the week end of October 2 to 5, 1954 Mr. and Mrs. George Christianson of 26 Warwick Street, Portland 5, Maine were away from home. During their absence 2 State School boys, escapees, broke window glass, entered house, ransacked to some extent, slept in beds, used bathroom, broke electric fixture and bulb, and took clothing, food, jewelry, etc.
