STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

RESOLVE, in Favor of John C. Bonnell of Portland.

John C. Bonnell; reimbursed. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the general fund of the state the sum of \$250 to be paid to John C. Bonnell of Portland, as a full and final settlement of his claim against the State, for damage done to his 1947 Ford sedan by two escapees from the State School for Boys.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

John C. Bonnell's car was taken from a service station which he was employed. The car was involved in a serious accident causing extensive damage to both cars and injuring three people.
