Frederick Standley; reimbursed. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the general fund of the State the sum of \$90.60 to be paid to Frederick Standley of South Windham, as a full and final settlement of his claim against the State for damage done to his 1951 Dodge by an escapee from the State School for Boys.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

In 1953 the 1951 Dodge of Frederick Standley was damaged by an escapee from the State School for Boys. Cost of repairs was \$90.60.
