STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

RESOLVE, in Favor of A. Edwin Madden of Gardiner.

A. Edwin Madden; reimbursed. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$178.90 to be paid to A. Edwin Madden as a full and final settlement of his claim against the state for refund of gasoline tax due him for a period ending August 27, 1952; said sum to be paid from the general highway fund.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Gasoline was used in unlicensed motor vehicles and application was prepared during August 1952, signatures received in April 1953 and submitted to the State in September 1953. During this period Mr. Madden was leaving for military service and cleaning up his business. The records were transferred from place to place, finally being stored with his brother Robert Madden, and the application for gas tax refund was mislaid until the period for application for refund had expired. Refund requested for \$178.90.
