#### STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

### RESOVE, in Favor of Leroy Foster of Amherst.

Leroy Foster; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$90 to be paid to Leroy Foster, of Amherst, as a full and final settlement for his claim against the State for 6 sheep killed by bear in October 1954; said sum to be paid from the dog tax fund.

#### STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mr. Foster lost 6 sheep at \$15 each. These were killed by bear in October 1954.
