AN ACT Relating to the Authority of the County Commissioners of Penobscot County to Convey an Easement in Land.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Authority of County Commissioners of Penobscot County to convey an easement in land. The County Commissioners for the County of Penobscot are hereby authorized and enabled to give, grant and convey an easement across land in the rear of the county jail and courthouse, to provide an exit from property adjacent thereto.
