IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

RESOLVE, in Favor of Chester Fredericks of Norridgewock.

Chester Fredericks; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$175 from the funds of the Department of Inland Fisheries and Game to be paid to Chester Fredericks of Norridgewock as a full and final settlement for his claim against the State for damage to his crops by deer in 1954.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Damage done in 1954 to crops of Mr. Fredericks by deer. Purpose of resolve is to reimburse him.
