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**Town of Washington; reimbursed. Resolved:** That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the general fund of the state the sum of \$419.62 to be paid to the town of Washington to reimburse them for aid given to Dorothy Bender, William F. Nickerson and Ronald Newton, state paupers.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Dorothy Bender, William F. Nickerson and Ronald Newton were given supplies in 1953 and 1954. The Department of Health and Welfare refused payment because the claims were over 3 months old.
