STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Membership on State Soil Conservation Committee.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 34, § 3, sub-§ I, amended. The 2nd sentence of subsection I of section 3 of chapter 34 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'It shall consist of the following 5 members: the Director of the State Agricultural Extension Service Dean of the College of Agriculture and the Director of the State Agricultural Experiment Station State Commissioner of Agriculture, who shall serve ex officiis; and 3 farmers who shall be appointed by the Governor with the advice and consent of the Council in the following manner: 1 from a list of 3 names submitted by the executive committee of the State Grange, 1 from a list of 3 names submitted by the executive committee of the State Farm Bureau Federation Association and 1 from a list of 3 names submitted by the Commissioner of Agriculture Maine State Association of Soil Conservation District Supervisors.'
