STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
FIFTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to the Teaching of the Industrial and Natural Resources of
Maine.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 41, § 11, sub-§ VII, amended. Subsection VII of section 11 of chapter
41 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new paragraph
which shall read as follows:

'It is further provided that a course in geography and the natural and industrial resources of Maine shall be taught in at least one grade from 7 to 12, inclusive, in all school systems, both public and private.'
